Maintain segregation of power, control, and communication cables to minimize interference. For long runs, use rollers or sheaves to prevent kinks and jacket damage during installation .

Grounding and Bonding

Metal trays must be properly grounded and bonded to ensure electrical safety. Use bonding jumpers across tray sections to maintain continuity and comply with electrical codes. This step is critical to prevent static buildup and reduce the risk of electrical hazards .

Labeling and Documentation

Label each cable clearly and maintain an updated wiring map. Proper documentation facilitates troubleshooting, future upgrades, and compliance inspections .
