This design allows directional bending along the flat plane, minimizing stress on the fiber core and reducing the risk of kinks during installation. Most butterfly cables use bend-insensitive single-mode fiber compliant with ITU-T G.657 standards, suitable for tight bends in residential or commercial deployments . Indoor cables are lightweight and flexible, while outdoor self-supporting versions include a steel messenger wire for aerial spans up to 50 meters .

Applications in Canada

In Canada, butterfly fiber optic cables are a strategic enabler for next-generation telecommunications, particularly in urban centers and underserved rural areas . They are widely deployed for Fiber-to-the-Premises (FTTP), connecting homes and businesses directly to high-speed networks, and for 5G infrastructure, where low-latency, high-capacity links are critical . The low-friction coatings and ultra-slim designs facilitate faster, cost-efficient installation, reducing labor and operational costs while improving durability in diverse environmental conditions .

Butterfly cables can be connected using fusion splicing, which welds fibers together for low-loss, permanent connections, or mechanical splicing, which provides temporary but secure joins without heat . Their flat profile makes them ideal for routing along walls, through conduits, or across irregular surfaces, and they are compatible with existing G.652.D infrastructure for seamless integration .
