These networks are designed with three tiers that facilitate strategic installation, management, and maintenance, and so on. The strategic design of a hierarchy network may comprise more than three layers. To calculate the required forwarding rate for a core switch, you can use the following formula: Forwarding Rate = Mpps + (Number of Gigabit Ports x 1.488 Mpps) + (Number of 100-Megabit Ports x 0.1488 Mpps).
