- o IP68-rated enclosures for waterproof and dustproof protection.
- o Hardened adapters and fast connectors to minimize signal loss.
- o Scalability for high-density fiber networks and future expansion. Fiber distribution boxes are passive components that do not process signals but ensure reliable connectivity and operational manageability. They can be installed indoors or outdoors, mounted on walls or poles, depending on network design .
