A distribution box receives power through an incoming cable and routes it through switching, distribution and protection components before supplying the outgoing circuits. Also called an electrical distribution box, power distribution box or DB box, it helps organize electrical connections, isolate circuits and protect wiring. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. Include protection devices like breakers, fuses, and surge protectors--each circuit should have its own protection. Comply with standards: Follow NEC, IEC, or local codes. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. Understanding its significance.
