Normal Access Point: Uses Ethernet ports (RJ45), typically 100M/1G ports, to connect to a switch or router. A fiber access point is simply a wireless AP equipped with a fiber port. Its core function is the same as a normal AP--broadcasting Wi-Fi signals to allow wireless-capable devices to connect. However, significant differences exist between them. Most APs come with at least one Ethernet port, while enterprise-grade or industrial-grade wireless access point with multiple Ethernet. If the SFP port is not in use, the port plug should remain in place and must be tightened to 12. To calculate path loss and determine how far apart to install the APs, consult an RF planning.
