- o **Measuring Instruments:** Some distribution boxes include ammeters, voltmeters, or other monitoring devices to display operational parameters and detect abnormal conditions .

Functions

- o **Circuit Protection:** Prevents damage to wiring and devices by interrupting power during overloads or short circuits .
- o **Monitoring and Control:** Allows operators to monitor electrical parameters and control circuits safely .
