Fiber Optic Connection Box (Termination Box)

A fiber optic connection box, also known as a termination box, optical distribution frame (ODF), or fiber patch panel, serves as the endpoint for incoming fiber cables. Its main functions include:

- o Termination and protection: Incoming fibers are terminated and secured to prevent damage and signal loss, typically around 0.2 dB per connection .
- o Organization: Provides structured management of fiber connections, often in data centers, FTTH setups, or enterprise networks.
- o Connectivity: Links drop cables to devices such as Optical Network Units (ONUs) or switches.
- o Flexibility: Allows easy addition, removal, or reconfiguration of patch cords without disturbing the main network.
- o Deployment: Usually installed in user-end locations, server rooms, or network cabinets. Termination boxes are designed for user-end accessibility, making them ideal for environments where frequent connection changes or monitoring are required .

Fiber Optic Splice Box (Splice Closure)

A fiber optic splice box, also called a splice closure, is designed to join two or more fiber optic cables, creating a continuous light path. Key features include:
