A red-sleeved fiber optic cable typically indicates an OM1 multimode fiber with a 62.5/125 μm core, used for short-distance, high-speed data transmission.

Cable Type and Specifications

Red-sleeved fiber optic cables are generally OM1 multimode fibers with a 62.5/125 μm core/cladding configuration, designed for 1G or 10G Ethernet applications over short distances. These cables often feature LC to LC duplex connectors, a 2.0 mm PVC jacket, and are OFNR riser-rated for indoor vertical runs, providing fire-retardant and flexible installation properties (FibercablesDirect) . The connectors are typically UPC polished, ensuring low insertion loss and high signal integrity.

Color Coding Significance

According to the TIA-598-C standard, fiber optic jacket colors indicate fiber type. Red jackets are commonly used for OM1 multimode fibers, which are optimized for legacy 62.5/125 μm networks. This color coding helps technicians quickly identify fiber types during installation, splicing, and maintenance, reducing errors and improving efficiency (Wolontek) .

Applications

Red-sleeved OM1 fibers are suitable for:

- o Data centers and enterprise networks for short-distance connections
- o Patch panels and backbone cabling in buildings
- o FTTx deployments where multimode fiber is required
- o High-speed LAN connections up to 275 meters at 850 nm wavelength (FibercablesDirect)

Splice Protection

When splicing red-sleeved fibers, fusion splice protection sleeves are used to safeguard the splice joint. These sleeves consist of a heat-shrinkable outer tube, hot-melt adhesive inner tube, and a stainless steel or ceramic strength member, providing mechanical reinforcement and environmental sealing. Proper installation involves sliding the sleeve over the fiber before splicing, performing the fusion, and then heating the sleeve to shrink and secure the splice (Reliable Splice Guards) .
