This ensures safe and efficient power delivery . 4. **Management Features:** Managed switches allow VLANs, QoS, and network monitoring, which can improve performance and security. Unmanaged or plug-and-play switches are simpler and suitable for most home setups . 5. **Build and Noise:** For home use, fanless designs are preferred for silent operation. Durable metal cases and surge protection enhance reliability . 6. **Transmission Speed and Uplinks:** Gigabit ports are standard for home networks. Some switches offer SFP or 10Gbps uplinks for future-proofing, though copper uplinks are sufficient for most home setups .
