- o Prefabricated rail terminals simplify installation and reduce errors .

- o Installation must comply with local electrical codes (e.g., NEC, IEC, BS 7671) and should be performed by a licensed electrician . 6. Future Expansion Select a box with extra ways (empty slots) to accommodate additional circuits, such as new appliances, lighting, or EV chargers . 7. Brand and Quality Choose a reputable manufacturer to ensure reliability, safety, and compliance with standards. Avoid compromising quality for cost, as the distribution box is a critical safety component .
