

Installation of Original Ladder-Type Cable Trays

Install accessories such as bends, tees, crossbars, and covers as needed, making sure they do not obstruct cable routing . For long runs, use cable tray rollers to facilitate smooth cable placement and prevent kinks .

Cable Laying

Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating them by voltage or function. Use cable ties or straps to secure cables while leaving enough slack for expansion or future adjustments. Ladder-type trays allow airflow, reducing heat buildup, so avoid overcrowding .

Safety and Best Practices

- o Avoid cutting or drilling structural members without approval .
- o Ensure all personnel are qualified and familiar with electrical hazards and local codes .
- o Verify that tray load does not exceed manufacturer specifications, typically 318-340 kg per hanger with a maximum support spacing of 3.6 meters .



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o Regularly inspect and maintain trays to prevent sagging, corrosion, or damage .
