

Installation of Secondary Distribution Box in Papua New Guinea

Overview

A secondary distribution box (also called a sub-distribution board) is used to distribute electrical power from the main service panel to various circuits within a building or facility. It provides circuit protection through breakers or fuses and allows for easier maintenance and load management.

Key Steps for Installation

- o Test for continuity, insulation resistance, and proper operation of breakers.
- o Coordinate with PNG Power Limited if the installation involves a new connection or load upgrade.
