For modular setups, pluggable systems like gesis(R) or RST(R) connectors allow safe, fast, and error-free connections .
4. **Safety Features** Include an emergency stop button for rapid shutdown in case of faults or accidents . Ensure GFCIs (ground-fault circuit interrupters) are installed to protect against electrical shock in wet conditions. Avoid random splitters or extension cords, as these increase the risk of overload and poor grounding .
5. **Compliance and Standards** Follow local electrical codes, NEC, IEC, or other relevant standards. Use UL/CE-certified components and document installation details for inspections . Temporary power boxes should comply with IEC 61439 for distribution and IEC 61535 for connectors .
6. **Maintenance and Inspection** Perform visual checks and multimeter tests before powering on. Schedule regular inspections to ensure long-term reliability, and label all circuits clearly for easy identification . Modular designs facilitate future upgrades or relocation.
