It divides a main electrical feed into smaller circuits, each protected by its own circuit breaker, such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers) or RCBOs (Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent protection), ensuring circuit protection, safety, and isolation for maintenance or emergencies . Large LV boxes are designed to handle higher currents, often up to 3150A, and accommodate multiple high-capacity circuits .
