

Methods for fixing plastic steel cable tray cover plates

Article Overview

Cable tray cover plates can be securely fixed using pressing plates, screw fasteners, buckles, padlocks, or seven-shaped buckles, depending on tray material and installation orientation.

Common Fixing Methods

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Pressing Plate Fixing: Holes are punched in the cover plate, and a pressure plate is placed over it. Screws secure the cover plate to the tray. This method works for both horizontal and vertical installations and provides strong, reliable fixation .

Screw Fastening: The cover plate is punched, and screws or rotating plate fasteners attach it to the tray. This method is suitable for all orientations and allows easy removal for maintenance .

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Buckle Fixing: The cover plate is secured without punching by bending folds at the ends of a buckle. This method is limited to horizontal installations, as vertical trays may allow the cover to slip .

Padlock Fixing: Provides additional security for sensitive or restricted areas, preventing unauthorized access to the cables .

Seven-Shaped Buckle Fixing: A specialized method for certain tray designs, offering moderate strength and quick installation .

Accessories and Supports

o **Mounting Clamps and Tray Hangers:** Used to secure trays to walls, ceilings, or floors, providing additional support for heavy cables .

o **Wall-Mounted Brackets:** Ideal for confined spaces, keeping trays stable and preventing sagging .

o **Ceiling-Mounted Supports:** Suitable for large areas, suspending trays for better cable access and ventilation .

o **Surface-Mounted Fixing:** For floor-level installations, using brackets or clips to secure trays .

Material Considerations

o **Plastic Trays:** Lightweight and corrosion-resistant, often compatible with screw or buckle fixing. Ensure

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fasteners do not crack the tray.

- o Steel Trays: Heavier and stronger, suitable for pressing plates, screw fastening, or padlock methods. Stainless steel or galvanized finishes improve corrosion resistance .

Best Practices

- o Always match the fixing method to the tray orientation and load requirements.
- o Use appropriate fasteners for the tray material to avoid damage.
- o Ensure accessibility for maintenance while maintaining secure attachment.
- o Consider environmental factors such as moisture or chemical exposure when selecting tray material and fasteners .
