- o Shuttered Adapters Shuttered adapters feature a spring-loaded shutter that automatically covers the adapter opening when no connector is inserted. This design prevents dust contamination and enhances eye safety by blocking stray laser light . They are ideal for environments with frequent connector changes or high dust exposure.
- o High-Density Adapters High-density adapters support multiple fibers per port, such as duplex (two fibers) or quad (four fibers), allowing more connections in limited space . These are widely used in data centers, MPO breakout panels, and parallel optics systems, where maximizing port density is essential.
- o Mode-Specific Adapters Single-mode (SM) adapters are optimized for 9 um core fibers, requiring precise alignment for long-distance, high-bandwidth signals, while multimode (MM) adapters accommodate 50/125 um or 62.5/125 um fibers, which are more tolerant of slight misalignments . Color coding (blue for UPC, green for APC) helps identify the type and polish of the adapter.
