To display information about the inline power for all interfaces or for a specific interface, use the `show power inline` Privileged EXEC mode command. `interface-id`--Specifies an interface ID. Show information for all ports. `auto`--Turns on the device discovery protocol and applies power to the device. Shows Yes for ports enabled to support PoE (the default) and No for ports on which PoE is disabled. Toggle the hierarchy tree under Learn About Power over Ethernet (PoE). PSE Power Management: means the power supply management mode (automatic, preempt, non-preempt).
