Distribution boxes come in various models, including main, sub, single-phase, three-phase, indoor, outdoor, and specialized types for lighting or control applications.

Primary Types by Function

- o Main Distribution Box (MDB): Receives power from the main supply and distributes it to multiple circuits. Common in homes, offices, and factories, often equipped with circuit breakers and safety devices for overload protection .
- o Sub Distribution Box (SDB): Receives power from the main box and distributes it to specific areas or floors, reducing long cable runs and improving system flexibility .
- o Industrial Distribution Box: Designed for harsh environments, capable of handling high loads, dust, moisture, and vibration, often with reinforced casings .

Types by Phase and Load

- o Single-Phase Distribution Boxes: Suitable for residential properties and small commercial loads, powering lights, fans, and small appliances .
- o Three-Phase Distribution Boxes: Used in industrial and large commercial facilities requiring higher power capacity, supporting heavy machinery and large equipment .

Types by Installation and Environment

- o Indoor Distribution Boxes: Installed in protected environments like homes, offices, or utility rooms, where exposure to weather is minimal .
- o Outdoor Distribution Boxes: Built for exposed environments, with strong enclosures and appropriate IP ratings to resist rain, dust, and temperature changes .
- o Surface-Mounted Boxes: Mounted directly on walls, ideal for retrofits and industrial settings .
- o Flush-Mounted Boxes: Embedded into walls for a clean, aesthetic appearance, commonly used in residential and commercial buildings .
- o Pole-Mounted Boxes: Designed for outdoor utility applications, such as street lighting .

Specialized Distribution Boxes

- o Lighting Distribution Boxes: Dedicated to managing lighting circuits with protective devices .
- o Power Distribution Boxes: Support sockets, equipment, and heavy machinery .
- o Control Distribution Boxes: Integrate control components like relays, contactors, and timers for automation or specialized control systems .

- o Metal Distribution Boxes: Offer higher mechanical strength and durability, suitable for industrial and commercial applications .
- o Plastic Distribution Boxes: Lightweight and corrosion-resistant, often used in residential or less demanding environments .
