- o Acoustic Panels or Foam: Attach removable acoustic foam or panels around the box to absorb sound. These materials reduce reverberation and dampen vibrations without permanent modifications .
- o Mass-Loaded Vinyl (MLV): Wrapping the box or the wall behind it with MLV adds mass, which blocks sound transmission effectively .
- o Seal Gaps: Use acoustic sealant or weatherstripping around the edges of the box to prevent sound leakage through small openings .
- o Soundproof Cabinet or Enclosure: If space allows, place a lightweight, ventilated soundproof cabinet around the box. Ensure proper airflow to avoid overheating.



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o Soft Surroundings: Adding rugs, curtains, or furniture near the box can help absorb ambient noise and reduce perceived loudness .

- o Ensure that any modifications do not obstruct access to the electrical box for safety or maintenance.
- o Avoid materials that could trap heat or interfere with ventilation, as electrical boxes require airflow.
- o Combining multiple methods, such as sealing gaps and adding acoustic panels, usually yields the best results .
