Lighting distribution boxes typically range in size depending on the number of outlets, with common wall-mounted boxes measuring from around 200x200x120 mm up to 800x600x300 mm.

Typical Sizes and Configurations

- o Material and protection: Boxes are typically made of plastic or metal, with protection levels varying according to the environment.
- o Outlet count: Boxes are available with 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, or 12 outlets, which directly affects the overall dimensions .
