- o Stranded vs Solid - Stranded wires are more flexible and easier to twist into pigtails, while solid wires are stiffer but may be easier to insert into screw terminals .
- o Application Environment - Automotive, industrial, or household wiring may require different gauges and insulation ratings to meet safety codes and temperature limits .
