

What is the smallest size junction box

- o Applications: Ideal for single switches, outlets, or small ceiling fixtures. Larger boxes are recommended for multiple devices or circuits . In summary, while 4x4x1.5 inches is the smallest standard junction box, the choice of box should always consider wire count, device type, and NEC compliance to ensure safety and functionality .
